

# THE PHOENIX COMBAT CLASSIC

October 23, 2010



Mark your calendars for the 4<sup>th</sup> annual Phoenix Combat Classic and again this year we will hold it to benefit the Phoenix PD Police Explorer Program.

This year the Classic's theme will be *Classic Rock* (all stages will be based on classic rock songs), we will have an excellent raffle table, shooter awards will work out to one plaque for every three shooters, lunch will be available, and we are already putting our devious minds to work to come up with interesting challenges.

## CATEGORIES

### **Duty Class:**

This class is only for competitors using street/duty gear. Holsters require thumb breaks, magazine pouches require flaps, no magazine extensions allowed, and all equipment retention devices are to be locked or snapped in place.

### **Stock Auto Class:**

Duty guns with open top holsters and magazine pouches, such as what plain clothes officers may wear. Good examples are the kydex holster and magazine pouches with factory high cap magazines, but magazine extensions are not allowed.

### **Challenge Class:**

10 round magazines or less, such as a Sig 220s, a 1911, 8-shot revolvers, etc. Open top kydex holsters and mag pouches are authorized.

### **Revolver Class:**

6-shot wheel guns only. This is for those interested in going old-school to bring their 6-shooters and show the young'uns how real cops did it back in the day. Open top kydex holsters and pouches are authorized, as are full-moon clips.

### **Team Shoot:**

At the end of the day, there will be a team shoot with 3 competitors per team.

***The intent of this match is to have cops shooting cop guns and competing on an even playing field, so unless you can prove you carry it at work, on a daily basis, leave the STIs, optics, \$3,000 dollar guns, etc. at home***

## Prizes

Awards for 1<sup>st</sup> to 3<sup>rd</sup> place in each division within each category (based on the number of shooters), 1<sup>st</sup> to 3<sup>rd</sup> place for each team member in the team shoot-off, the top female shooter, top reserve officer, and top retired officer.

## REGISTRATION

Early registration is \$70.00 before September 18, 2010; after that it will be \$80.00 up to and including the day of the match, *but no shirt will be included*. Fee includes a match shirt, if registered before 9/18/2010, and 1 raffle ticket.

The match is limited to the 1<sup>st</sup> 120 shooters.

### **Benefiting the Police Explorer Program**

\$5.00 from each registration will go to the Explorer Program, and we are going to hold a side match that will cost you \$5.00 per run and each run will get you one raffle ticket for the Explorer Benefit side match raffle.

All proceeds from this side match will go to the Explorer Program and there will be prizes on the prize table for those who do this side match.

- This match is open only to current, retired, and reserve police officers.
- Expect to be tested on skills that will include accuracy, speed, and weapon manipulations.
- You will need: a handgun, at least 3 magazines, at least 5 speed loaders, at least 250 rounds of factory or factory equivalent ammunition.
- Ammunition must be of at least .38 or 9mm caliber and light loads are not allowed.
- Eye protection is required for everyone at all times when on or near the ranges.
- Hats and ear protection are required for everyone while on the shooting bays.
- Range Officers running the stages have authority over safety violations. Match Director has final say up to and including disqualification.
- The match will be run as a cold range.
- No alcohol will be allowed on the grounds.
- Additional rules will be covered at shooter's briefing.
- Bring a friend to shoot the match with and to share the fun
